RUTH JAMIESON (1897-1984) COLLECTION

INTRODUCTION

Ruth Jamieson, long-time resident of West Lafayette, was a graduate of the Cincinnati College of Music; she studied with Isadore Phillip of Paris, Tobias Bathay of London, and Leopold Godowsky of Chicago. She taught at the Cincinnati Conservatory of Music. For many years Miss Jamieson gave music instruction from her home.

The collection consists primarily of letters with Miss Jamieson received from former music students: Noel Lee, Neil Burton Carson, and Eugene Buskirk. The letters are dated 1940 to 1945 and include writers' observations about college, war, the army, and music, etc.

One of Miss Jamieson's correspondents represented by the collection, became a professional musician and composer; recordings of his works are presently available at the West Lafayette Public Library.
